Embassy Ballroom Championships Event Rules and Policies

Dress Code (evening sessions):

Men:

- Men must be in coat and tie (standard or bow tie)
- Exceptions to the "tie rule" are: turtlenecks, bolo ties, ascots, jeweled collars,

ruffled collars and banded collars.

- Military Dress, ethnic and/or religious attire will also be allowed.
- No outdoor jackets, shorts, sandals, flip flops, sneakers or sneaker-like shoes are allowed.
- Leather jackets (with buttons) and leather pants are allowed. No casual attire will be allowed. Think business attire!

Women:

- Women must be in a dress, cocktail dress, elegant skirt & blouse combination, pant suit with a matching jacket (think business suit), or evening pant suit ensemble.
- Military Dress, ethnic and/or religious attire will also be allowed.
- No outdoor jackets, Capri pants, shorts, flip flops, sneakers or sneaker-like

shoes are allowed.

• No casual or inappropriate attire will be allowed. Think elegant attire!

General Rules:

- All smoking is restricted to the designated smoking area only.
- No profanity, loud, or lewd behavior will be tolerated.
- No firearms or other weapons will be permitted on the premises.
- Young children must remain under supervision of a Parent / Guardian or responsible adult.
- No signs, posters, etc. will be placed on the premises without permission of organizer.
- Attendees must adhere to ticket restrictions regarding re entry and seating, see ticket back for details.

- Dancing is a physical activity, and as such, involves some risk of physical injury. Guests recognize this and agree to release The Embassy Ballroom Championships and its Owners, Agents or Employees from any and all liability in the event of accidental injury or death.
- The Embassy Ballroom Championships, it's Owners, Agents or Employees are not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.

Ticket Orders- All sales are final. Since tickets are a one-of-a-kind item and not replaceable, there are no refunds, exchanges or

cancellations. If an event is postponed, tickets will be honored for the rescheduled date. New tickets will not need to be issued. It is the buyer's responsibility to confirm changes to the date or time of event. The Embassy Ballroom Championships will not issue exchanges or refunds after a purchase has been made or for lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed tickets. When you receive your tickets, please keep them in a safe place

Delivery- Due to risk of theft or loss, tickets to the event will not be shipped or mailed. Event tickets can be picked up at Will Call only and will be made available starting the evening before the first session (See event schedule for times).

Authentic Tickets- All tickets are guaranteed to be authentic tickets and valid for entry to the event that the ticket is for, unless otherwise noted in the ticket description.

Same, Equal, or Best Available - Occasionally, the tickets you order may no longer be available at the time your order is received. In this situation, we will issue tickets for what we deem to be the next best available for your request. Best available may vary depending on number of seats requested or value of tickets.

Permitted Use- You agree that you are only authorized to visit, view and to retain a copy of pages of this Site for your own personal use, and that you shall not duplicate, download, publish, modify or otherwise distribute the material on this Site for any purpose other than to review event and promotional information, for personal use, or to purchase tickets or merchandise for your personal use, unless otherwise specifically authorized by The Embassy Ballroom Championships. The content on this Site is the property The Embassy Ballroom Championships and/or its suppliers and is protected by U.S. and international copyright laws.

Video and Camera restrictions:

No performance or event presented at The Embassy Ballroom Championships shall be photographed, videotaped, broadcast or recorded for personal or commercial use, sale or distribution of any kind without the express written consent of the organizers.

No videotaping equipment of any kind is allowed in the ballroom except by persons authorized as media by show management. If found in violation, the violator agrees to surrender recording media immediately at the request of show management.

Consequences of violation

- First warning: Delete photos/videos
- Second warning: Confiscation of tickets and removal from the ballroom

Should any guest observe a violation of these policies by another attendee, please bring the violation to the attention of event management immediately.

Late entries and entry cancellation policy:

Late entries and cancellations, especially cancellations occurring after the event has started, can be detrimental to the event schedule and require staff hours to correct schedule deviations. Therefore, the following fees for late entries and cancellations must be applied.

Late entries: All entries received after the completion of the event time schedule will be assessed a \$50 per person administrative and change fee.

Entry cancellations after closing date: All entry cancellations received after the posted closing date will be assessed a 10% administrative fee. This fee is 10% of the total number of entries cancelled.

Entry cancellations during event: All entry cancellations that occur after the commencement of the event will be assessed a 20% administrative fee. This fee will be 20% of the total entries cancelled.
